NEW IN 2023: Member-s

NEW IN 2023: Training

LIFT EVERY VOICE: EMPOWERING YOUTH VOICE

We collaborated with young people to create a new training aimed at empowering mentors and youth-centric initiatives. This training is designed to equip youth-serving professionals and mentors with effective strategies for enhancing youth empowerment and autonomy. Central to the training is a panel of young voices, showcasing their innovative ideas on how adults can effectively support them and foster their leadership roles.

MENTORING MINDSET

We introduced the Mentoring Mindset framework to Nebraska, training two staff members and three consultants to deliver this nationally recognized resource to youth-serving programs, schools, and workplaces.

In partnership with Nebraska's Department of Education, we launched this training during the 2023 Nebraska State Education Association University (NSEA U), Additionally, we delivered presentations at Nebraska Council of School Administrators' Days and the Greater Omaha Chamber's CODE Conference.

NEW IN 2023: *EML/*

EMERGING MENTORING LEADERS INSTITUTE

We launched the Emerging Mentoring Leaders Institute, a professional development opportunity for mentoring leaders from new and grassroots programs serving BIPOC and LGBTQIA2S+ communities. This comprehensive training program provides mentoring leaders with the tools and resources needed to strengthen their organization so they can better support young people through a critical lens.

In the first year, we led two EMLI cohorts which included six emerging leaders from Lincoln and 13 from Omaha. We continue to support these mentoring programs with our no-cost consulting and training services.
